

TIMELINE OF FLORIDA CORONAVIRUS EXECUTIVE ORDERS

MARCH 1, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-51

Florida Department of Health ordered to issue a Public Health Emergency due to COVID-19.



MARCH 9, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-52

Florida State of Emergency declared due to COVID-19.

MARCH 23, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-80

Anyone **flying** into Florida from a state with significant COVID-19 community spread must self-isolate on arrival in Florida for 14 days or the duration of their visit to the state – whichever is shorter.



MARCH 24, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-83

Florida Surgeon General and State Health Officer ordered to issue a public health advisory recommending all Florida residents avoid social gatherings of 10 or more people and encouraging anyone who can work remotely to do so.

MARCH 27, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-86

Anyone **driving** into Florida from a state with significant COVID-19 community spread must self-isolate on arrival in Florida for 14 days or the duration of their visit to the state – whichever is shorter.



APRIL 1, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-91

Senior citizens and people with underlying medical conditions that make them susceptible to COVID-19 are ordered to stay at home and take all necessary measures to prevent exposure.

APRIL 1, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-92

Amendment clarifies that the Governor's Executive Order 20-91 supersedes any orders issued by local (city, county or municipal) officials.



All Florida residents must limit their movements and interactions outside the home to only those that are necessary to obtain or provide essential services or activities.

APRIL 2, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-93

Governor orders emergency resources be provided to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) and orders the Department of Management Services (DMS) and CareerSource Florida to assist the DEO with their unprecedented volume of requests for reemployment assistance and streamline all processes (such as alternative methods for new applications).

APRIL 2, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-94

Any mortgage foreclosures or evictions are suspended for 45 days starting April 2, 2020 so people who may have lost their jobs due to COVID-19 can't be kicked out of their homes.



APRIL 3, 2020

FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-95

Any funds Florida businesses receive from CARES Act loans won't be charged state taxes.
