

MOST DANGEROUS AUTO ACCIDENTS



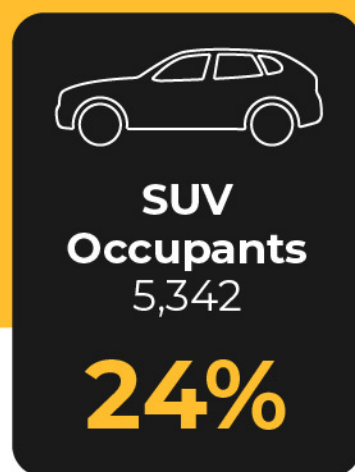
Pickup trucks and SUVs are more likely to be involved in single-vehicle fatality accidents due to a higher chance of rolling.

Occupants in pickup trucks and SUVs are less likely to die or be seriously injured in multiple-vehicle accidents because of their greater weight.

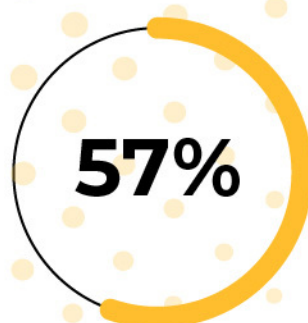

FATALITY CRASH TYPES



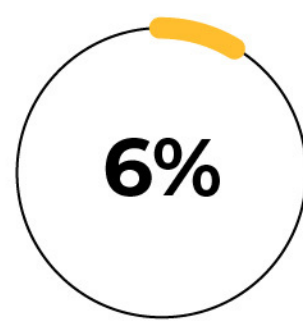
