Types of Traumatic Brain Injuries and Their Consequences





Concussions – Head trauma or rapid deceleration causes the brain to make contact with the inside of the skull, potentially resulting in varying degrees of damage



Edema - Brain swelling and dangerous pressure




Hematoma - Buildup of blood in the skull



Skull fracture - Cracks in the skull caused by severe trauma



Anoxic brain injury - Lack of oxygen to parts of the brain
